FADE IN:

EXT. TRAIN STATION - DAY

The train station is situated in between hills. The sun shines down and a gentle breeze blows through the trees. A purple mist hangs at cloud level.

A Caucasian MAN dressed in a black suit sits at a table with a beautiful women. Her name is DAISY. They are both in their twenties. They are surrounded by luggage.

DAISY

They look like white elephants.

MAN

What the fuck are you talking about?

DAISY

The mountains look like white elephants.

A WAITER walks over with a jug of water.

BEGIN FLASHBACK SEQUENCE:

INT. BAR - NIGHT

Daisy serves dinner with a smile to an old couple. She is dressed in a generic waitress uniform.

DAISY

Enjoy your dinner.

She walks towards a door and opens it.

INT. KITCHEN - NIGHT

She walks past cooks preparing food, picks a bag up off the side and opens another door.

EXT. PARKING LOT - NIGHT

She sits down on the bonnet of a car, pulls a cigarette out of her bag, lights it and begins to smoke.

A young man comes out of the back door. He is dressed in white overalls. His name is JIM. He pulls a cigarette out of his pocket, walks towards a car and stands next to it. He holds a lighter to his cigarette and tries to light it.

It does not work. He tries a couple more times but it still does not work. He tosses it on to the floor.

DAISY (O.S.)

Do you want a light?

He looks over at her and smiles.

JIM

Yes please.

He walks over and takes her lighter. He takes a draw on his cigarette and gives it back to her.

JIM (CONT'D)

Thanks.

DAISY

No problem.

He looks up at the night sky.

JIM

Do you ever wonder what is out there?

DAISY

Not really. Do you?

JIM

Yeah all the time.

DAISY

So what do you think is out there?

JIM

Other planets with people on for sure.

(beat)

My name is Jim by the way.

He holds his hand out. Daisy shakes it.

DAISY

Daisy.

JIM

I see you around the joint all the time.

DAISY

Oh yeah?

JIM

Yeah. It's good to put a name to a face.

DAISY

Likewise.

He stubs his cigarette out.

JIM

See you around.

Daisy smiles and Jim walks away.

INT. BAR - NIGHT

About twenty people sit drinking and talking. Christmas decorations are hanging up around the room and "ROCKING AROUND THE CHRISTMAS TREE" by Brenda Lee is playing through a stereo.

Close in on Daisy drinking a beer through a straw. She has a party hat on. A woman opposite her says something and Daisy starts laughing.

A man turns the music off and walks up to a microphone. His name is RAY, he is in his mid forties and his balding head has tinsel draped across it.

RAY

(into microphone)

Hey everyone!

GROUP

Speech! Speech!

RAY

(into microphone)

Okay. Well I just want to say a massive thank you to everyone who has come tonight.

WOMEN (O.S.)

Love ya Ray!

RAY

(into microphone)

Love you too!

(laughs)

Also, I would like to thank you all for making my fifth year here a breeze!

WOMEN (O.S.)

Your welcome!

RAY

(into microphone)

Let's get back to the music! Thanks again.

Everyone claps as "LAST CHRISTMAS" by George Michael blares out.

INT. BAR - LATER

Daisy puts her coat on and walks towards the exit. Ray sits at the bar. They are the only people left in the room.

DAISY

You going to be okay to clean up on your own Ray?

RAY

(drunk)

Yeah, no problem.

DAISY

Perhaps leave it until Tuesday?

RAY

I'll be fine.

DAISY

Can I call you a taxi?

RAY

That would be great.

EXT. PARKING LOT - NIGHT

They are sat on a bench. Daisy holds a phone to her ear.

DAISY

(into phone)

Okay thanks.

She hangs up.

DAISY (CONT'D)

It'll be about twenty minutes boss.

RAY

I'm sorry.

DAISY

Why are you sorry?

RAY

That I couldn't hire out somewhere for you guys and you had to have the party here.

DAISY

No worries! Everyone came, it was great.

Ray grabs her breast.

DAISY (CONT'D)

Come on Ray let's not be stupid.

She pulls his hand off her breast. He goes in for a kiss, she dodges.

DAISY (CONT'D)

Stop it!

He forces himself onto her. She kicks and struggles.

JIM (0.S.)

Hey!

Jim runs over and pulls him off her, he punches Ray in the face which makes him fall to the floor.

JIM (CONT'D)

Motherfucker!

He stands above Ray and grabs him by the scruff of the neck. Daisy gets up and pulls Jim away.

DAISY

Come on let's just go.

They walk away.

JIM

Fucking scumbag!

Daisy walks to her car.

JIM (CONT'D)

Are you okay?

Daisy frantically tries to open her car door without her car keys.

JIM (CONT'D)

Daisy stop.

She falls to her knees and begins to cry. Jim kneels down next to her and puts a hand on her shoulder.

JIM (CONT'D)

It's okay. I'm here.

INT. APARTMENT/LIVING ROOM - NIGHT

Jim lays sleeping on his sofa.

INT. APARTMENT/BEDROOM - NIGHT

Daisy sleeps in his double bed.

INT. DINER - DAY

Jim and Daisy sit eating bacon, eggs and beans.

JIM

I am still looking.

Daisy sips a coffee.

DAISY

Thank you.

JIM

For what?

DAISY

For just being there.

JTM

Have you found a house?

DAISY

Yeah.

JIM

Oh great! Where?

DAISY

Just an apartment on fourteenth boulevard.

(beat)

I'm sorry.

JIM

For what?

DAISY

That your still looking for a job. I feel responsible.

Jim puts his hand on hers.

JIM

That asshole deserved it.

They stare into each others eyes. Jimmy picks up a piece of her bacon with his fork.

DAISY

Hey that's mine!

She throws a bean at him. They laugh.

EXT. FIELD - DAY

Jim and Daisy lay on the grass under an oak tree. Dappled sunlight shines onto the scene making pretty patterns on the ground.

DAISY

Do you ever stop and think how beautiful the world is?

JIM

Yeah sure.

DAISY

No, I mean really think.

JIM

Yeah.

DAISY

What is your favorite thing about the world?

JIM

Snow.

DAISY

Really?

JIM

Yeah. I like snow because each flake is individual like a human. And I think it's amazing how snow is actually frozen water.

(beat)

What about you?

DAISY

I love the sun. It is crazy to think one day it won't actually be here. The sun is half way through it's life cycle, did you know that?

JIM

Of course!

DAISY

(laughs)

Silly question.

(beat)

I like hills too, especially white ones, I think they look like elephants.

JIM

Hmm, I guess they do.

Jim stretches.

JIM (CONT'D)

You just need to stop and look sometimes. It puts everything into perspective.

They look at each other.

EXT. FIELD - NIGHT

They are still laying there looking up at a cloudless sky. Stars are shining brightly.

JTM

You don't really get single stars, they are usually in pairs.

He reaches for her hand. She turns and looks at him. He moves his head towards hers.

Suddenly a flash of purple light that covers the whole sky for four seconds.

DAISY

What was that?!

JIM

(confused)

I don't know.

EXT. OUTSIDE BAR - NIGHT

Jim and Daisy sit at a table watching a thin purple strip in the sky.

DAISY

What is it?

JIM

I don't know.

DAISY

Has there been anything on the news?

JIM

No.

(beat)

Let's drink beer.

DAISY

Big ones.

JIM

Yes two big ones.

INT. APARTMENT - NIGHT

Daisy opens the door and is greeted by Jim who is holding a takeaway meal.

JIM

Hey.

DAISY

Hey.

INT. APARTMENT/BEDROOM - NIGHT

Daisy sits on a bed while Jim puts a CD into a stereo.

"NEVER BE MINE" by Angel Olsen starts to play.

He walks over to her and sits beside her on the bed. They stare at each other. Jim puts his arm around her neck and they begin to kiss passionately. They lay on the bed together.

INT. CHAPEL - NIGHT

Jim and Daisy stand next to each other holding hands. He is dressed in a suit and she is in a wedding dress. A CHAPLIN stands in front of them holding a book.

CHAPLIN

Do you take...

EXT. PRIVATE GARDEN - NIGHT

Jim and Daisy dance closely together. The song "BOUND" by Ponderosa Twins Plus One is playing.

INT. DOCTOR'S ROOM - DAY

Daisy sits on an examination bed with Jim by her side. A DOCTOR scans her belly and the image of a baby can be seen on a screen next to the bed.

DOCTOR

Would you like to know the sex?

Daisy nods.

DOCTOR (CONT'D)

One less thing to think about right Mom?

The Doctor continues to scan.

DOCTOR (CONT'D)

It's a...

END OF FLASHBACK SEQUENCE.

EXT. TRAIN STATION - DAY

The Man pours himself a glass of water.

DAISY

They're great hills. I didn't mean they look like actual white elephants, just the color.

MAN

Have another drink.

DAISY

Jim used to agree.

He slides his glass of water along the table to her.

BEGIN FLASHBACK SEQUENCE:

INT. APARTMENT/LIVING ROOM - DAY

A man dressed in a suit holds out his hand to Daisy. Another Man also in a suit stands behind her.

MAN #2

You must come with us.

DAISY

No. Where is my husband?

MAN #2

You must come now.

DAISY

No! You are scaring me!

The Man behind her grabs her around the neck. She screams and kicks out.

MAN

Stand still!

She screams.

The Man in the suit puts some handcuffs on her.

DAISY

No! Get off me!

MAN

Stand fucking still!

MAN #2

You will hurt the baby.

DAISY

Get off me!

MAN

Inject her now!

MAN #2

Is it safe?

MAN

Do it fucking now!

The Man pulls a needle out of his pocket and pierces her neck with it. She slowly relaxes and closes her eyes.

INT. VAN - DAY

Daisy's eyes are shut. Suddenly they open. She jumps forward in her seat. Someone catches her. She looks up to see Jim.

DAISY

What's happening?!

JIM

I don't know sweetheart but we need to stay calm and do whatever they say.

DAISY

But our baby!

JIM

Nothing is going to happen to her! I'm here!

They sit down and hold one another.

JIM (CONT'D)

It's okay I'm here.

INT. BUILDING - DAY

There are two lines of people walking side by side down a corridor. Jim and Daisy are near the front of one of the queues. In front of them are two armed soldiers and a man holding a scanner. He scans one person at a time.

MAN WITH SCANNER

(to a person)

Left.

The person walks down a corridor to the left.

MAN WITH SCANNER (CONT'D)

(to the next person)

Left.

The person goes left.

Jim and Daisy are next. He scans Jim.

MAN WITH SCANNER (CONT'D)

Left.

He scans Daisy. The scanner begins to beep loudly.

MAN WITH SCANNER (CONT'D)

Right.

DAISY

No!

MAN WITH SCANNER

Right please maam.

Jim tries to follow her but is forced to the left. Daisy is forced to the right.

DAISY

Jim!

JIM

I'll find you! I will!

INT. ROOM - NIGHT

Daisy sits at a table with a clipboard and a piece of paper on it. Her hands are cuffed to the table leg. The door opens behind Daisy and in walks a man in green scrubs who taps her on the shoulder, sits down opposite her and begins to read from the piece of paper.

GREEN SCRUBS

Daisy Weir?

DAISY

Yes.

He continues to read.

DAISY (CONT'D)

What is happening?

GREEN SCRUBS

It's really an awfully simple operation, It's not really an operation at all.

DAISY

I'm sorry?

GREEN SCRUBS

I know you won't mind it. It's really not anything, We just let the air in and then it's all perfectly natural.

DAISY

I don't know what you mean?!

GREEN SCRUBS

I'll go with you and I'll stay with you all the time.

DAISY

Where?!

The man gets up.

GREEN SCRUBS

Wheelchair!

The door opens and a man pushes a wheelchair into the room. He unlocks the handcuffs and helps her into the wheelchair.

DAISY

What is happening?

She is wheeled out of the room.

INT. OPERATION THEATRE - NIGHT

Daisy lays asleep on a green bed. She has a facemask on which is connected to a ventilator that is breathing for her. A SURGEON pokes a tube into her pregnant belly and begins to make an incision.

END OF FLASHBACK SEQUENCE.

EXT. TRAIN STATION - DAY

The Man sits and watches Daisy drink water from a glass.

The Waiter comes out of the building.

WAITER

The train is coming in five minutes.

Daisy stands up and begins to walk away from him. He grabs her arm.

EXT. TRAIN STATION - 10 MINUTES LATER

The train has pulled into the station. The Man puts the cases on board.

The Waiter is pulling down shutters on the outside windows of the station.

INT. TRAIN - DAY

Daisy sits looking out of the window. She anxiously holds her bump.

EXT. OUTSIDE GLASS DOME - NIGHT

There is a large, glass, dome-shaped building in the middle of a field. People walk in and out of it through a revolving door. Also army vehicles are pulling up to it.

Daisy stands watching three men carrying her suitcases to a truck.

MAN

Follow me.

They walk towards the revolving door.

INT. GLASS DOME - NIGHT

Daisy walks along looking up out at the night sky. Stars are twinkling, every few seconds a rocket ship is launched from a pad outside the dome and a purple haze hovers over the building. The Man and Daisy stop outside a heavy duty door. The Man types a number combination into a keypad attached to it and the door opens.

MAN

Come on.

DAISY

Please no!

MAN

Come on.

DAISY

No!

MAN

Listen to me this is safe for you and your baby.

DAISY

I want my husband.

MAN

Only you can go.

The Man grabs her by the hand and drags her through the doorway to another door.

DATSY

Please!

MAN

Listen to me. You have a chance to live.

He taps a number combination into the keypad next to that door. It opens onto the launch pad outside the building. There is a silver rocket ship surround by a chain link fence in front of them. People are gathered around outside the fence.

EXT. LAUNCH PAD - NIGHT

Daisy and The Man walk towards the space ship. The people outside the fence scream for help and stick their hands through gaps in the fence. Soldiers use their rifles to bat them away. The door on the space ship opens.

JIM (0.S.)

Daisy!

Jim is standing at the fence. A soldier pushes him away but he just keeps running back to the fence. The Man grabs Daisy by the arm and leads her over to Jim. She drops to her knees and clings to his fingertips that are clutching the fence. Daisy begins to cry. Jim's eyes begin to water but he holds back the tears. Daisy taps her bump.

DAISY

It's the only thing that's made us unhappy.

JIM

We'll be fine afterward. Just like we were before.

DAISY

What makes you think so?
(takes a deep breath)
And you think then we'll be alright
and be happy?

JIM

I know we will. Lots of people are having it done and afterwards they were all so happy.

She tries to smile.

JIM (CONT'D)

I think it's the best thing to do.

DAISY

And if I do it you'll be happy and things will be like they were and you'll still love me?

JIM

I will always love you!

DAISY

I know. But if I do it, it will be nice again. If I say thinks are like white elephants, and you'll like it?

JIM

I'll love it and always love it.

DAISY

Then I'll do it. Because I don't care about me.

Jim squeezes her hand.

DAISY (CONT'D)

I care about you.

She places her other hand on his hand.

DAISY (CONT'D)

We could have all of this.

She gestures towards herself and then towards Jim.

JIM

No we can't.

DAISY

We can have the whole world!

JIM

No we can't.

DAISY

We can go everywhere.

JIM

No, we can't. It isn't ours anymore.

Daisy looks to the sky.

DAISY

(shouts)

It's ours!

JIM

No, it isn't. And once they take it away, we'll never get it back.

(MORE)

JIM (CONT'D)

(beat)

But what we can have is this!

He gestures towards her.

JIM (CONT'D)

This moment right now forever!

The Man pulls Daisy to her feet.

DAISY JIM

I love you!

I love you!

She is taken to the ship. She looks back at Jim before being forced inside.

INT. ROCKET SHIP - NIGHT

The Man straps her into a leather seat with a four way harness. He tilts the chair back so she is facing the ships ceiling, puts a pair of headphones over her ears, presses a couple of buttons, pulls down on a lever and closes the door of the ship.

"EARTH ANGEL" by Marvin Berry and The Starlighters begins to play through her headphones as the ship's thrusters roar and the engines whine. It blasts off into the air.

EXT. OUTSIDE TAKE OFF AREA - NIGHT

The crowds shake the fence violently. A man with a running circular saw walks through the crowd and begins cutting the fence. It rips a hole through the mesh which people run through to get into the take off area. Soldiers fire bullets at them, killing some and further enraging the others. They descend on the soldiers and began beating them. It is utter chaos.

But Jim just stands and watches the ship blast off into space with tears trickling down his face.

EXT. SPACE - NIGHT

The ship holding Daisy is speeding through the atmosphere and past purple orbs.

CUT TO:

INT. ROCKET SHIP - NIGHT

Daisy closes her eyes and grits her teeth.

CUT TO:

EXT. SPACE - NIGHT

It begins to slow down until it is just floating.

EXT. SPACE - LATER

The ship is stationary against a back drop of distant dim stars. The lights on its hull twinkle and ebb soothingly.

INT. ROCKET SHIP - NIGHT

Daisy is still titled back in her seat looking at the ceiling. "DARK WAS THE NIGHT, COLD WAS THE GROUND" by Blind Willie Johnson plays through her headphones. A bright white light suddenly shines into the ship. Daisy closes her eyes.

INT. OPERATION THEATRE - NIGHT

Daisy sits bolt up right and gasps. She is connected to a sats machine. She is dressed in a green gown and is sitting on a steel framed bed. She feels her belly, the baby has gone!

Two female nurses walk into the room and over to where she is sitting.

NURSE #1

She is safe Daisy.

DAISY

Show me her now!

NURSE #2

Okay follow us.

INT. CORRIDOR - NIGHT

Daisy and the Nurses walk along a corridor. There are windows on both sides and out of the window is just darkness and stars.

INT. ROOM - NIGHT

In the room are about twenty five cots containing sleeping babies. Daisy is taken over to one of them.

NURSE #1

This is your baby.

Daisy looks down at a beautiful looking baby in pink pyjamas. She reaches down for her. A Nurse grabs Daisy's hand.

NURSE #2

You cannot touch.

NURSE #1

Now if you will follow us.

Daisy blows a kiss to her baby and follows the nurses.

INT. CRYOGENIC'S LAB - NIGHT

Daisy looks around the room at frozen men and women standing in cryogenic chambers. There is a free one at the end. The nurses grabs her and drag her towards it.

DAISY

No! Please!

She is forced inside.

DAISY (CONT'D)

I want to see my baby!

NURSE #1

You will sweetheart.

NURSE #2

Don't worry.

The door is closed on Daisy. She hammers on the glass. A nurse presses buttons on a keypad. Daisy is suddenly frozen. The nurses walk away. Daisy stands completely motionless.

INT. CRYOGENIC POD - DAY

(The song "TAKE GOOD CARE OF MY BABY" by Bobby Vee plays over the next four scenes.)

Daisy's P.O.V - A woman and a little girl with gills on her neck are standing in front of the pod. The girl is about three years old. They wave at her.

INT. CRYOGENIC POD - DAY

Daisy's P.O.V - A man and a girl about ten years old wave at her.

INT. CRYOGENIC POD - DAY

Daisy's P.O.V - A teenage girl stands with her arms crossed looking at Daisy.

INT. CRYOGENIC POD - DAY

Daisy's P.O.V - A young women stands close to the pod and puts her hands against the glass then kisses it.

INT. CRYOGENIC POD - DAY

Daisy's P.O.V - The young women stands in front of Daisy. A man presses buttons on a keypad.

YOUNG WOMEN (to Daisy)
Mom. It's time to go home.

FADE OUT.
